

# Ring Size Guide

## 🖨️ How to set up your printer

1. Use US Letter paper (8.5" × 11").
2. In your print settings, select **actual size** (100%).
3. Make sure "**scale to fit**" is **unchecked**.
4. After printing, place a standard credit card along the test line to confirm the scale is correct. If the edges align, you're all set.



## Method 1: Measure a ring you already own

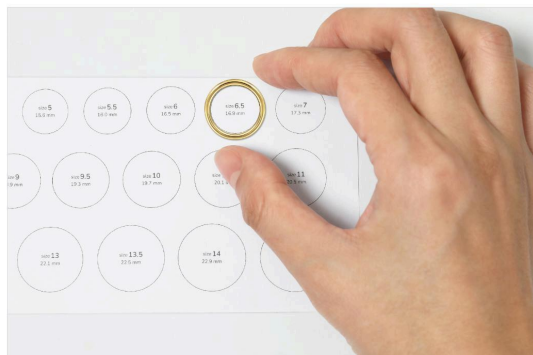
### Option 1: Use a Ring Size Chart

1. Choose a ring that fits the finger you plan to wear your Gabriel & Co. ring on.
2. Place your ring over the printed ring size chart.
3. Match it with the circle where the inside edge of your ring lines up exactly with the outer edge of the circle.
4. If your ring falls between two sizes, it's best to choose the larger size for a more comfortable fit.



### Tip for using the guide (example with size 6.5):

When testing against a size 6.5 circle, the black circle should fit neatly inside your ring, just touching the inner edge all the way around.



## Option 2: Measure your ring with a ruler



**Step 1** Pick a ring that fits the finger you want to wear your new ring on.



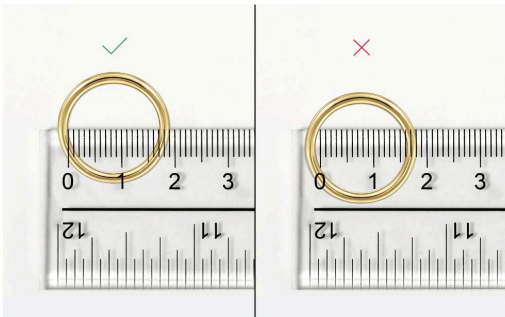
**Step 2** Place the ring flat on a ruler or tape measure. Measure straight across the inside of the ring, from one inner edge to the other, at the widest point. Round up to the nearest millimeter.



**Step 3** This number is your ring's inner diameter. Use the size chart on page 4 to find your corresponding ring size.

### Tip for best accuracy:

Only measure the inside of the ring (not the metal). Make sure the ring is lying flat and that you're using millimeters for the most precise result.



## Method 2: Measure ring size with string or tape

Here's how to find your ring size in 3 easy steps.



**Step 1** Wrap a string, paper strip, or measuring tape around the base of your finger.



**Step 2** Mark the point where it overlaps to form a complete circle.

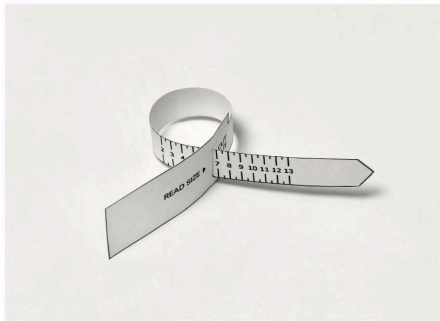


**Step 3** Lay it flat and measure the length in millimeters. Subtract 3.5mm from your measurement, then check the ring size chart (page 4 & 5) to find your correct size.

For example, if you measure 51mm, subtract 3.5mm your true size would be 47.5mm (~size 4.5)

### Method 3: Use the printable Gabriel ring sizer

1. Print and cut out the ring sizer at the end of this page.
2. Be sure to keep the numbers, arrows, and slit intact.
3. Insert the pointed end through the slit to form a loop.
4. Wrap it around your finger (letters facing out). The letter nearest the slit is your ring size.



#### Don't have a ring?

Use Method 2 with a string or tape, or Method 3 with the printable Gabriel ring sizer. For more accuracy, place a credit card on the first page as a reference.



#### Don't have a printer?

Hold one of your existing rings against the sizing circles on your screen. To confirm accurate sizing, place a credit card against the card outline in Step 1 and adjust your screen's zoom until it matches.



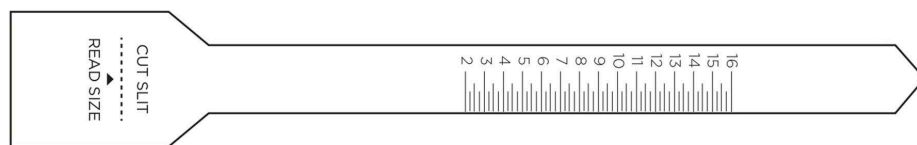
#### Looking for a perfect fit?

Once we receive your ring, resizing takes 2–3 weeks and is shipped back to you free of charge. You also have 30 days to exchange your piece with confidence.

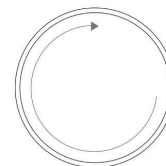
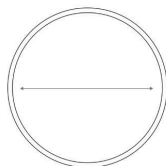
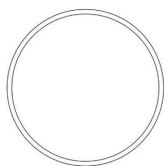
